5. School Report:

There are plans for a French Immersion program to begin at Barr Colony School in the fall of 2019 – there is a minimum of 15 students needed to be enrolled for the program to run. A shortened blanket activity was completed at the meeting as well, it was led by 1 teacher from LCHS & 3 students. The activity is to show understanding of the history and how we can all have a part of it moving forward. This can be an extremely emotional exercise.
- Our school survey will be held in conjunction with Student Led Conferences. Linda and Maddison have volunteered on behalf of the SCC to help promote the survey during conferences. There will be an approximate 3 week window for families to complete the survey and at the end one name will be drawn for a prize.

 - Jack Kemp Community School will be hosting the LPSD track meet from 4:00-9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 5, 2019, the SCC will run the concession.
 - We also provide funds for the following: LPSD fun run, treats for the K-2 & Grade 3-6 track meets, the scholarships in September and supporting the building of the outdoor classroom/seating space.
 - Linda was able to attend the 2nd Annual SCC Conference in North Battleford. We are part of the Treaty 6 Territory. There were many excellent speakers that presented at the conference.
