. Lieutenant governor and chiefs attendance for raising of the treaty flags has been postponed due to rising covid cases. School was beginning to be spruced up for this event including a welcome poster in a variety of languages, old banners came down. They hope to continue in school improvements.

i. SK Health has changed isolation protocol. School had 3 diagnosed cases in May 2021, but currently are already seeing our 5th case since the start of September 2021. If they are isolating because of a case in the class they are to be fully masked in the classroom. In school transmission has been very low throughout covid as it seems to be transmission is happening in home.

. Christmas Meal: Last year cookie decorating kits were provided in lieu of this at a cost to SCC of \$323.90 (coop sponsored other half).

i. Christmas Books: cost of approximately \$1000

ii. SCC Scholarship: \$500

iii. Student lead conference teachers treats \$300 (both spring and fall conferences combined) typically a meal has been provided instead, but due to Covid we got creative and it was very well received - so will continue with the different options, rather than meals

iv. Christy made suggestion to provide a hot meal (like hot lunch) in the month of December and cookie decorating as opposed to our traditional Christmas meal. This would make cost of a "Christmas meal" to students considerably less and still provide something special. Budget suggested by Heather of approximately \$2000 between cookies and hot lunch. There are currently 340 students in the school. This will be revisited at the October meeting to see where Covid restrictions are at.

v. All activities combined costs approximately \$3800

vi. Elena mentioned school budget has lead to a lot of cuts including some cultural, arts and other opportunities for students. Technology cost have risen, especially in regards to licensing. Elena to discuss with teachers requests or suggestions for wants/needs in the upcoming year. All ideas or requests are to go through Elena. If SCC approached by teachers, please redirect them to Elena so that the process is streamlined and she is aware of what teachers are needing/wanting.

a. Possible Fundraising for 2021-2022 Year

Ham & Turkey Bingo- online option. Gift cards suggested to be used again instead of actual meat so it's less issues with purchasing, delivering meat as well as for those who have cultural or religious beliefs that impact participation with meat being a prize.
